

DIAMOND PUTTY

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION:

DIAMOND PUTTY is a hand kneadable steel reinforced epoxy putty that cures steel-hard within minutes. Specifically designed for repairs on pipes, tanks, and pressure vessels. It is extremely tough and durable with exceptional adhesion to a wide range of metals. In one hour, it can be drilled, tapped, filed, machined, or painted.

FEATURES:

- Min/Max Service temperatures: -91°F to 550°F (-68°C to 288°C)
- Application temperatures: 50°F to 212°F (10°C to 100°C)
- Will not rust or oxide.
- Impervious to chemicals and corrosion.
- Does not run, drip, or shrink.
- Adheres to wet surfaces, underwater, and within chemicals.
- Certified to ANSI/NSF 61.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

- 1. For best adhesion, clean and roughen bond area prior to application.
- 2. Break off desired amount of putty and knead to uniform color (consistent gray color free from black specs).
- **3.** Repairs should be in place before hardening begins (2 minutes).
- For underwater applications, work the mixed putty forcefully into the substrate and hold until adhesion takes effect.

STORAGE AND HANDLING:

The shelf life of DIAMOND PUTTY is 36 months at 77°F (25°C). For best results, store in original, closed containers in a cool, dry place out of direct sunlight.
